The article deals with the problem of the government control of labor migration in the Crimea. It analyzes the efficiency of the Federal Targeted Programme on the Crimean peninsula. The insight into the governmental regulation of issues related to migration policy had been provided. It should be noted that due to the fact of quite a large investment by the Russian Government of the Crimean Republic and Sevastopol was identified the migration attractiveness of the Crimea to labor migrants both from mainland Russia and from abroad. Also have been determined complexities of integration to migrant workers: the problems with processing papers, the cost of the patent, their level of professionalism, etc. Based on the study the authors propose the following examples of solutions to this problem: activation of the processes on improving migration management system in the Republic of Crimea; acceleration of the process of creating a single center on work with migrants on the territory of Crimea; improving the efficiency of the socio-cultural adaptation of migrants in the region, involving both government and business structures.
