This article analyzes the role of the Black Sea region in the United States global geostrategy in 1991 – 2013. For the first time in the national historiography the author has conducted a systematic analysis of the US National Security Strategy in order to identify the evolution of approaches to the Black Sea region. It was concluded that since the end of the "cold war" the Black Sea region has been the object of a stable US interest in connection with their desire to establish control over Eurasia, which is formalized in projects to support the fragmentation of the geopolitical space, diversification of energy transportation routes, and stabilizing the Greater Middle East. The dominant factor in US policy towards the Black Sea region is an interest in the energy transportation route from Central Asia and the Caspian Sea to Europe.
